1. Review and Herald, March 22, 1887

There is nothing that Satan fears so much as that the people of God shall clear the way by removing every hindrance, so that the Lord can pour out his Spirit upon a languishing church and an impenitent congregation. ... When the way is prepared for the Spirit of God, the blessing will come.

2. Christ's Object Lessons, page 408

Without the Spirit of God a knowledge of His word is of no avail. The theory of truth, unaccompanied by the Holy Spirit, cannot quicken the soul or sanctify the heart. One may be familiar with the commands and promises of the Bible; but unless the Spirit of God sets the truth home, the character will not be transformed. Without the enlightenment of the Spirit, men will not be able to distinguish truth from error, and they will fall under the masterful temptations of Satan.

3. Prophets and Kings, page 221

The call to place all on the altar of service comes to each one. We are not all asked to serve as Elisha served, nor are we all bidden to sell everything we have; but God asks us to give His service the first place in our lives, to allow no day to pass without doing something to advance His work in the earth. He does not expect from all the same kind of service. One may be called to ministry in a foreign land; another may be asked to give of his means for the support of gospel work. God accepts the offering of each. It is the consecration of the life and all its interests, that is necessary. Those who make this consecration will hear and obey the call of Heaven.

4. Christ's Object Lessons, page 312

Righteousness is right doing, and it is by their deeds that all will be judged. Our characters are revealed by what we do. The works show whether the faith is genuine.

5. Desire of Ages, pages 20-21

In the beginning, God was revealed in all the works of creation. It was Christ that spread the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth. It was His hand that hung the worlds in space, and fashioned the flowers of the field. "His strength setteth fast the mountains." "The sea is His, and He made it." Ps. 65:6; 95:5. It was He that filled the earth with beauty, and the air with song. And upon all things in earth, and air, and sky, He wrote the message of the Father's love.

Now sin has marred God's perfect work, yet that handwriting remains. Even now all created things declare the glory of His excellence. - 9. Jn 3:16-18 Jesus came to provide salvation for those who <u>believe</u> (Heb 11:6!)
 - a. Those who believe are <u>not</u> condemned -Rom 8:1
 - b. Those who don't believe are <u>already</u> condemned
- 10. Jn 3:19-21 Light has come into the world —to <u>everyone</u> –Jn 1:9
 - a. People respond in one of <u>two</u> ways:
 - (1) Either they <u>hide</u> from the Light —so they can keep doing what they want
 - Gen 3:8, Rev 6:15-17 Throughout history people have tried to <u>hide</u> from God
 - Heb 4:13 –But all things are naked & open to Him whom we must give <u>account</u>
 - (2) Or they <u>come</u> to the Light
 - Allowing God to <u>work</u> in and through them —> righteousness & salvation
- 11. Jn 15:1-8 –If we are connected to Jesus we will "bear <u>fruit</u>" = <u>blessings others</u>
 a. Eph 2:10, Lk 13:6-9 –God <u>created</u> us to bless others —this is our purpose –PK 221
 b. Lk 18:18-25, DA 20-21–Can't be one of God's people without being involved in ministry
